

Financial Policy

We accept cash, checks, money orders, and most major credit cards. For treatments or procedures over \$2,500, we also offer CareCredit and Alphaeon financing on 6-month and 12-month deferred-interest plans. Financing is an agreement between you and the financial institution, not our office, and is not available for Botox, fillers, skin care, aesthetician services, or discounted/special pricing.

Cosmetic & Elective Surgery Fees

A **25% deposit is required to schedule surgery** and is **non-refundable**. Final payment is due no later than 10 days before surgery. If you cancel, the 25% deposit is forfeited. Any additional payments made beyond the deposit will be refunded, minus a 4% credit card fee, any garment restocking fee, and any CareCredit/Alphaeon financing fees. Refunds for cash payments are issued by check within 72 hours. A no-show on the day of surgery forfeits the full deposit, and a new deposit is required to reschedule.

Cancellation & Rescheduling Policy

- Rescheduling your surgery for a 2nd date: non-refundable \$250 administrative fee
- Rescheduling your surgery for a 3rd date: non-refundable \$500 administrative fee
- Cancelling within 3 weeks of surgery: non-refundable \$1,500 administrative fee

Cancellations and late reschedules affect the facility, anesthesia providers, Dr. Godwin, and other patients waiting for a surgical date. We appreciate your understanding and courtesy. No-shows on your date of surgery forfeit your deposit entirely and incur the cancellation fee of \$1,500. A service fee of \$50 applies to any returned checks.

Non-Surgical Aesthetic Treatments

Botox, injectables, chemical peels, laser hair reduction, IPL, laser skin resurfacing, and similar treatments are priced per treatment or as a package and are due in full at the time of your appointment. To receive a discounted package price, the full package price must be paid upfront. All aesthetic treatments and treatment series are non-refundable, and financing is not available for these services.

Hospital, Facility & Anesthesia Fees

Surgical facility and anesthesia fees are billed separately, directly to you, by the hospital, surgical center, and/or anesthesia provider. These fees are set independently and are outside our control; they are subject to change, and rescheduling your surgery may place you under a different facility rate.

Insurance & Medicare Coverage

Our office does not participate with, bill, or accept any commercial or private health insurance plans, and we do not bill secondary or supplemental insurance of any kind. This is discussed with every patient at the time they inquire about an office visit, so that you can make an informed decision before scheduling.

For patients with Medicare, our office will bill Medicare directly for covered services. You are responsible for the portion Medicare does not pay, which typically includes the **20% coinsurance** and any unmet **annual deductible**. If Medicare denies a claim, you will be responsible for the full cost of the service billed.
